REUNIFICATION PROCEDURES


Pursuant to Articles XLI: OATH OF FEALTY, and by the authority granted to the Office of the Deputy for the Orient of North Carolina, I write this Executive Order to provide instructions relative to reunification in this Orient.


For any Prince, Grand Inspector General, Sovereign Grand Inspector General, or Loyal Lady who may have knowledge of a former member who joined an unrecognized, clandestine Scottish Rite body, and you are aware that the former member desires to reunite with a consistory or assembly of the Dr. G. Wesley Allen Council of Deliberation and A.P. Rogers Golden Circle, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, Prince Hall Affiliation, Southern Jurisdiction of the United States of America, Memphis, Tennessee, I, hereby, provide the following instructions:

The individual must:

1. Write a letter to his or her current organization withdrawing membership.
2. Send a copy of the letter to the Commander-In-Chief or the Loyal Lady Ruler of the Masonic body the individual desires to join.
3. Complete the re-instatement process for current years report and any delinquent dues and assessments owed along with a \$20 administrative fee to the Consistory or the Assembly the individual desires to join.
4. No office or rank not attained through USC, Tenn. will be recognized.
5. All documents MUST be approved by the Deputy and State Grand LLR (Assembly).
6. SGIG's request must be approved by the Deputy and sent to the USC for approval.
